

Step 1:

Cut all the parts according to the pattern, and color the leather as your wish, I did as blue. (Please notice the two circles in the picture, when I make this wallet, I didn't design the corner as round corner, but during the working process I found round corner is more charming, so I cut two round corners later.)



Step 2:

Paint tragacanth gum on flesh side, and polish with flesh side wood block, you can buy this tool from our website:

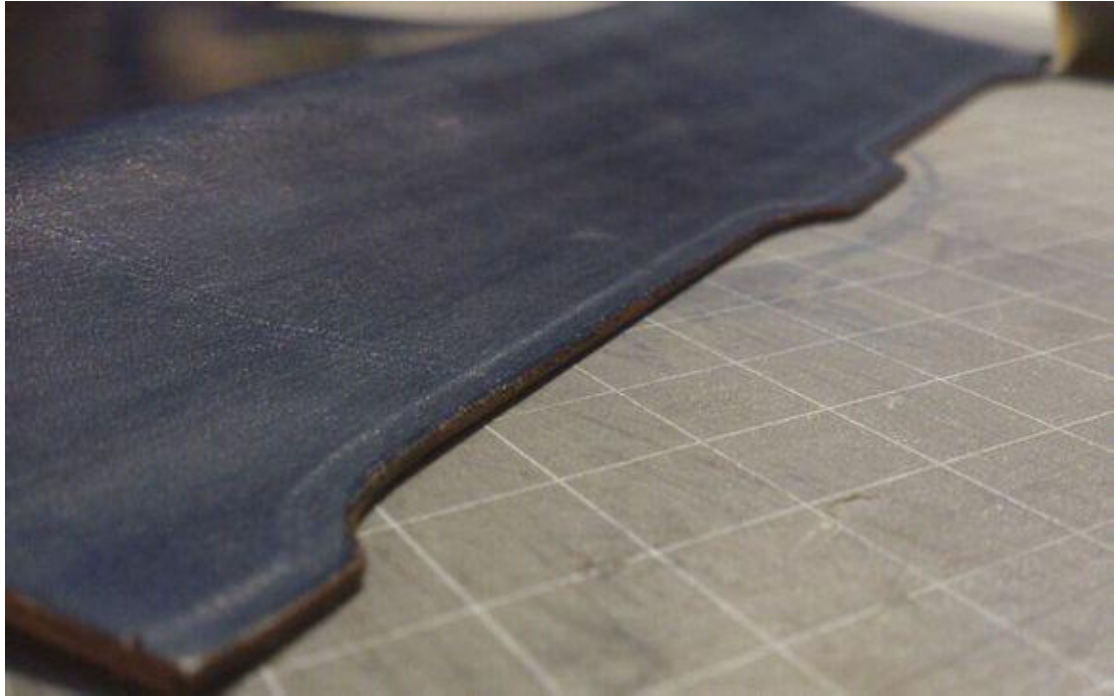




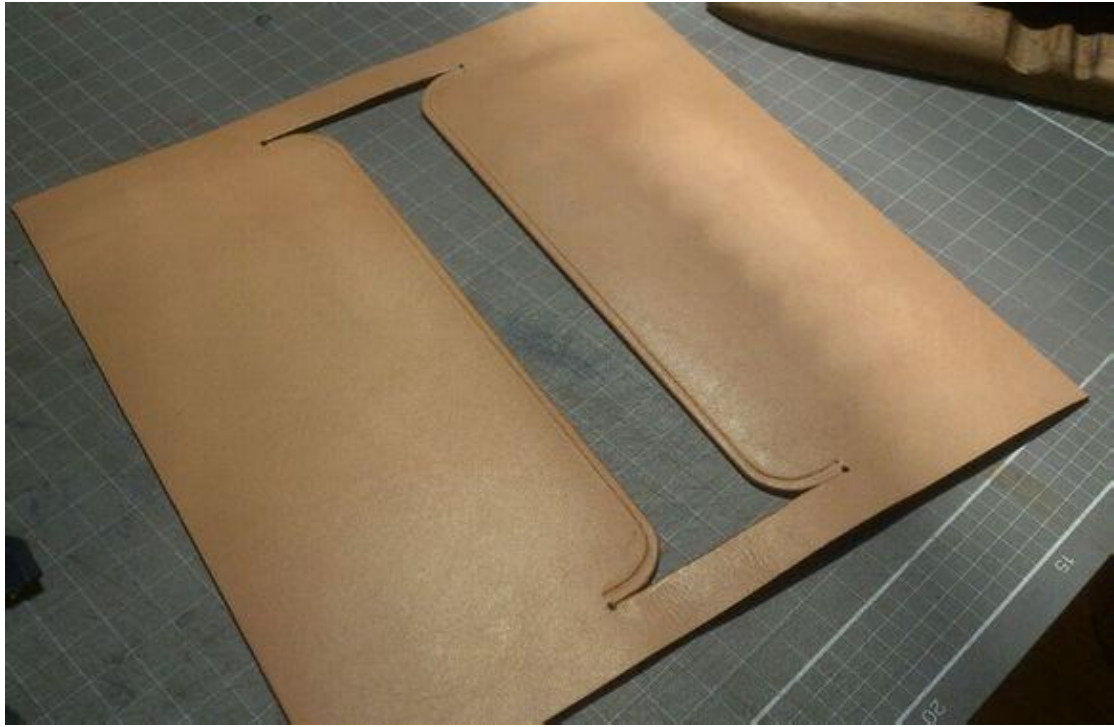
Step 3:

Polish the edge and make decoration lines with pressor.









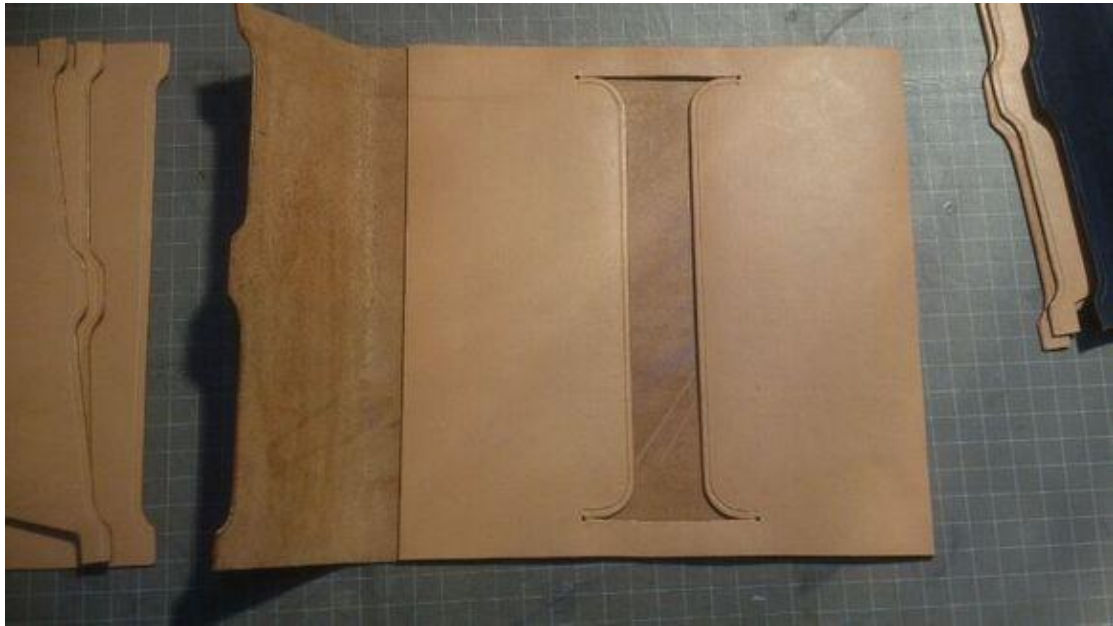




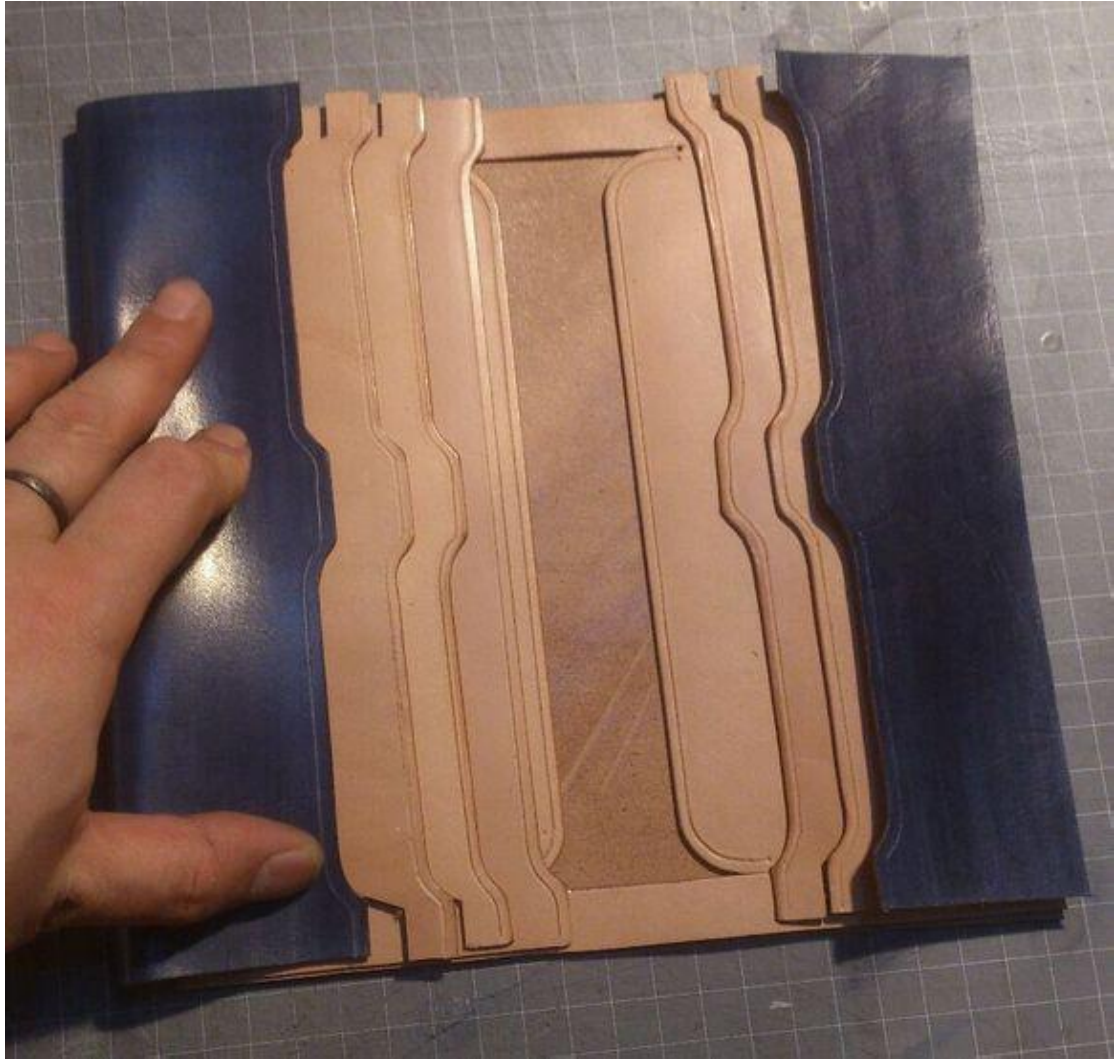


Step 4:

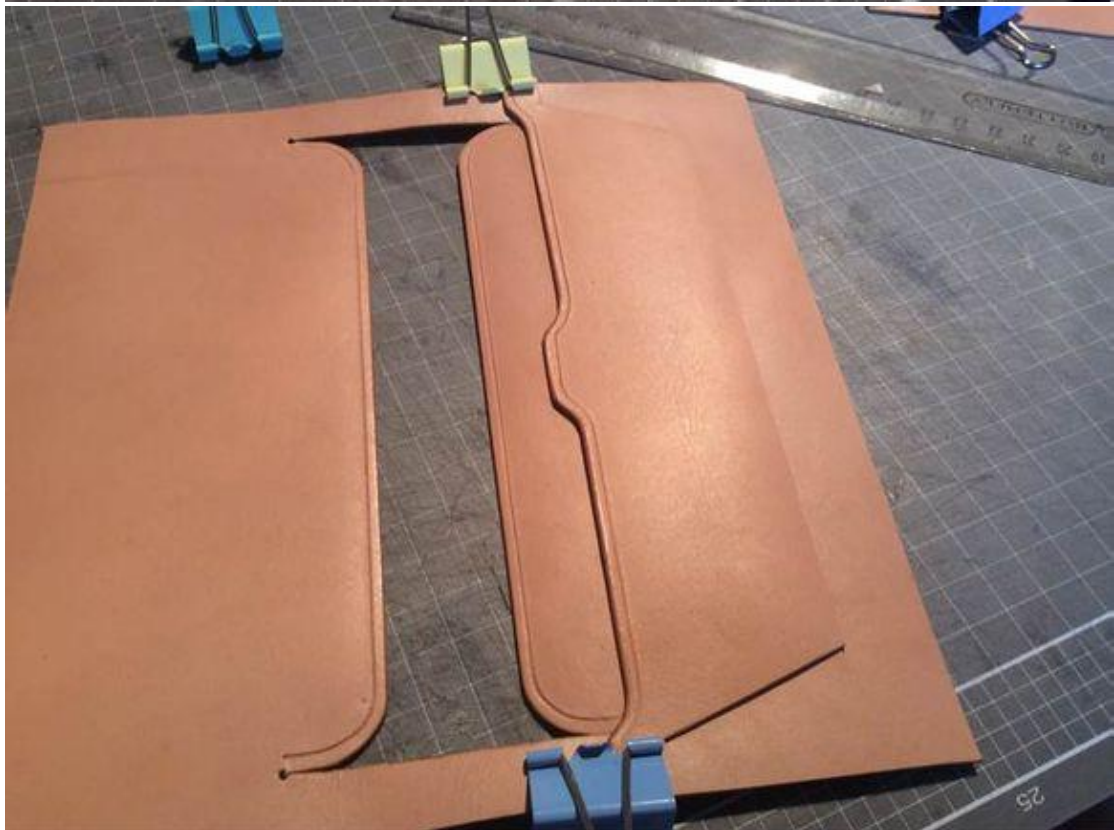
Let's put all pieces on the right position to take a look.





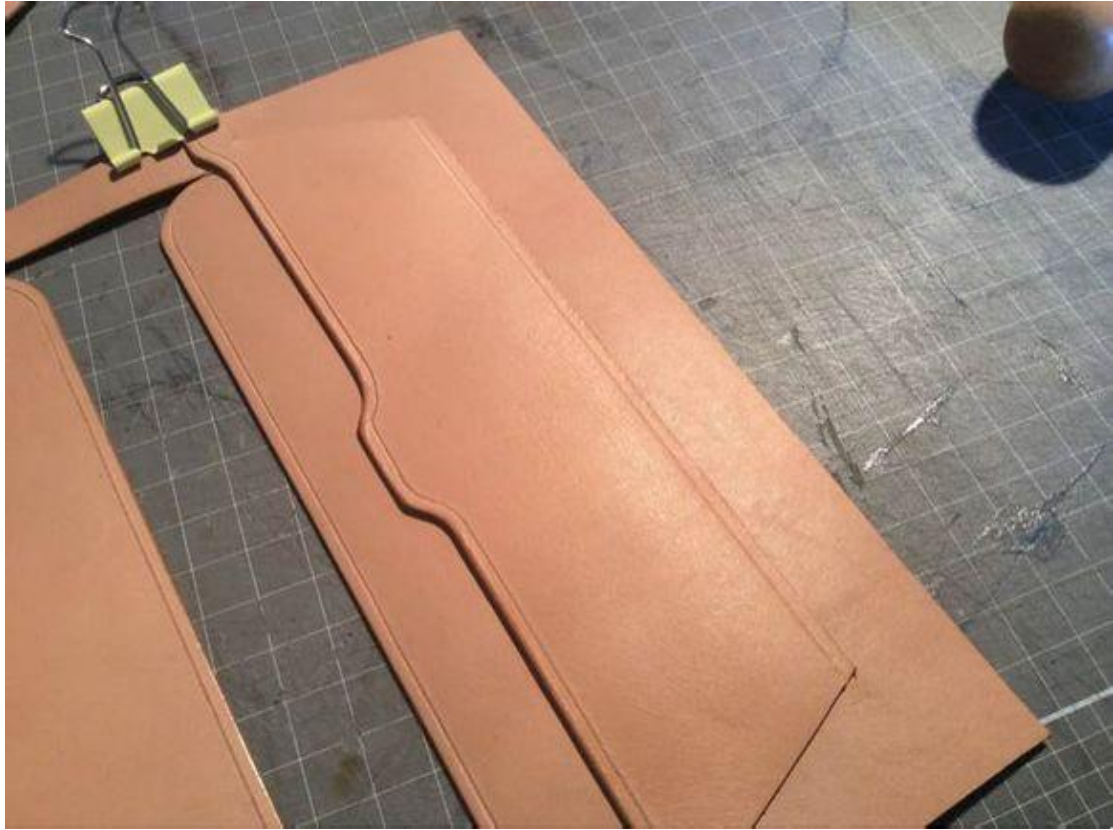


Step 5:  
Glue one Internal card slot on Lining and use clips to fix it.



Step 6:

Then we prepare to sew this card slot on lining, draw a line with compass. And punch holes with your chisel. Sew them together.

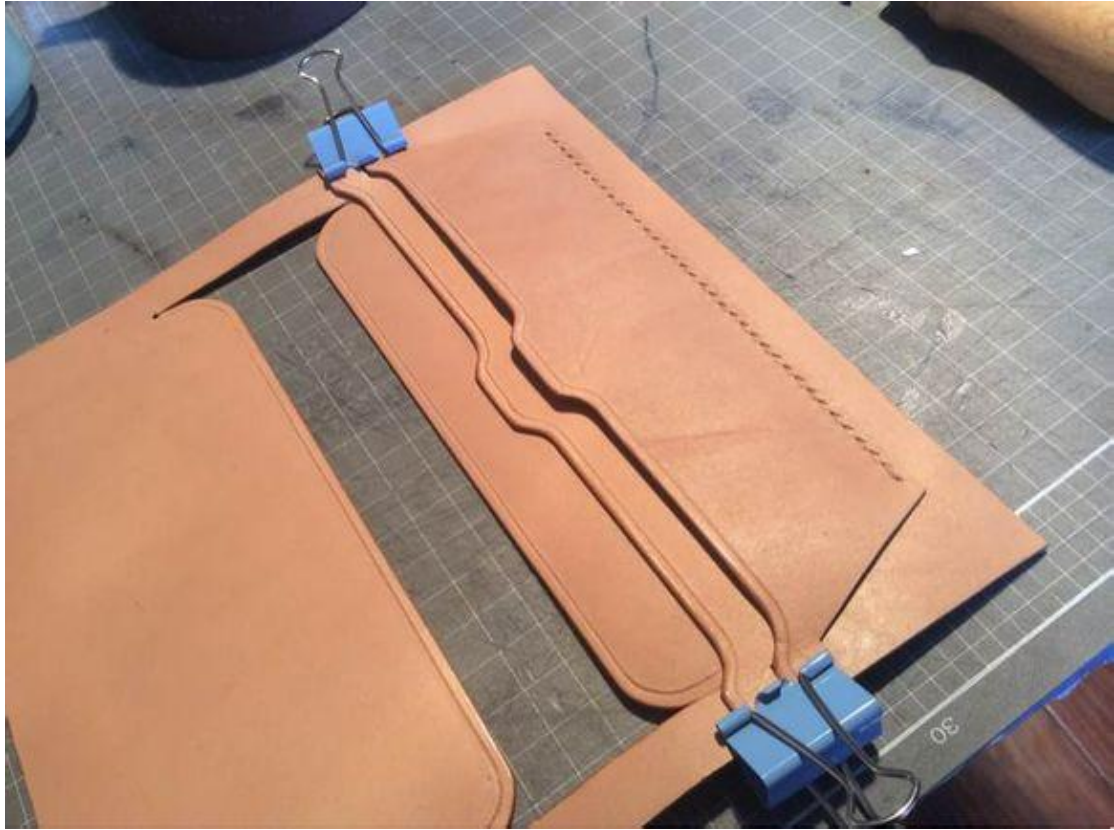








Step 7:  
Do the same as the first piece.





Step 8:

Now a very important step, skive the edge, I use a very easy way to show to new player, use the sand paper to grind to thin.....



Step 9:  
Paint white glue and put the external card slot on.



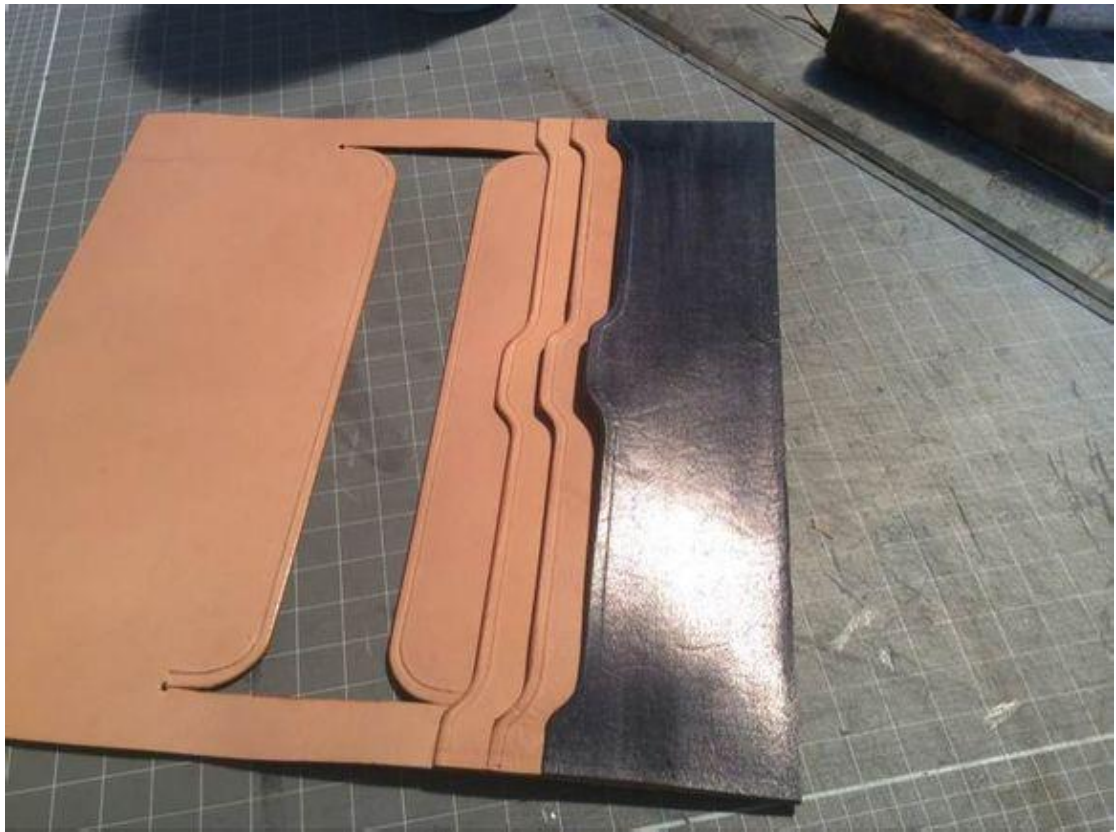




Step 10:

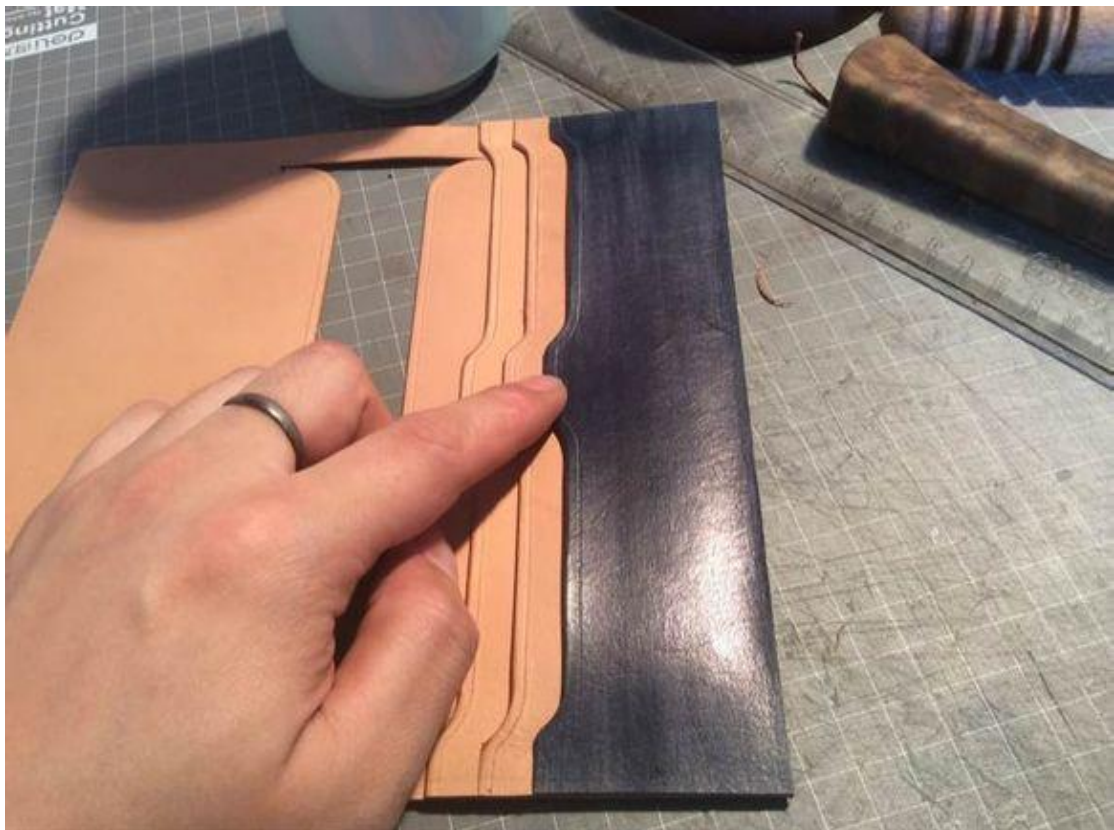
After 10 mins, the glue is dry, then take all clips away. We found the card slot is a little disformed. So let's cut neatly.







Step 11:  
Prepare to sew the middle line.

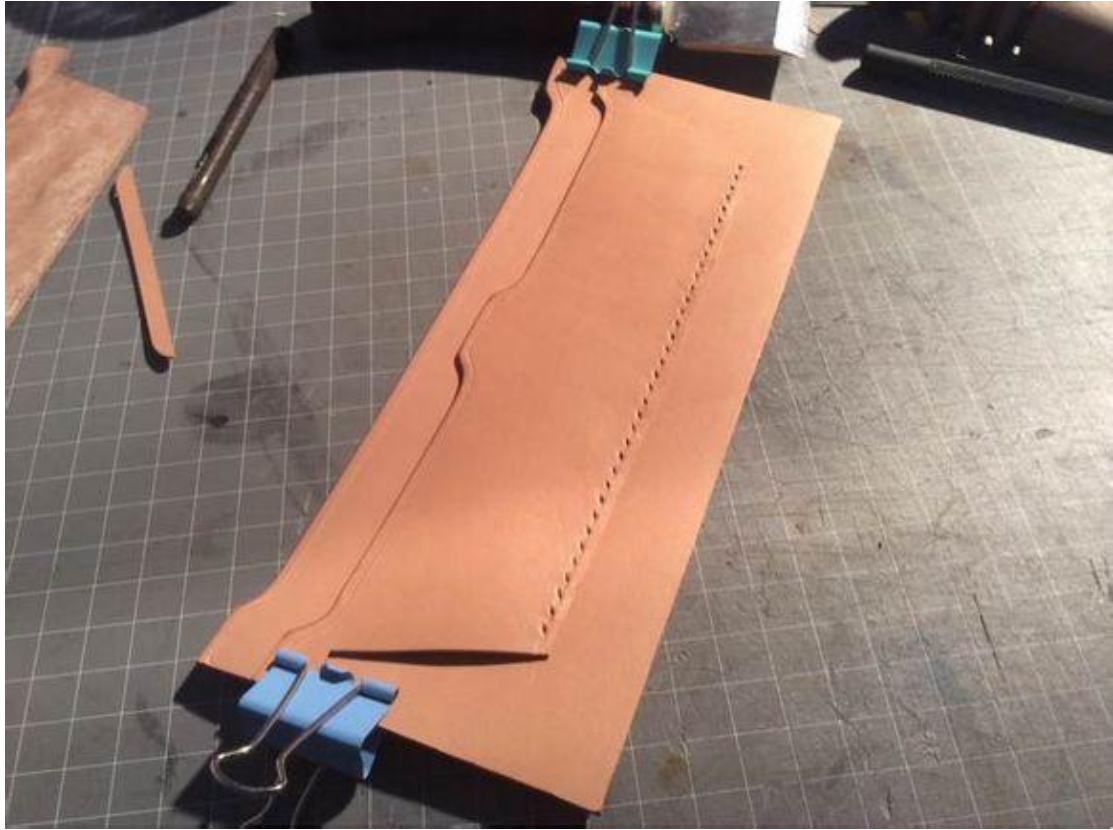






Step 12:

Almost the same step, put a piece of internal card slot on card slot back leather and sew them together. Then the second.





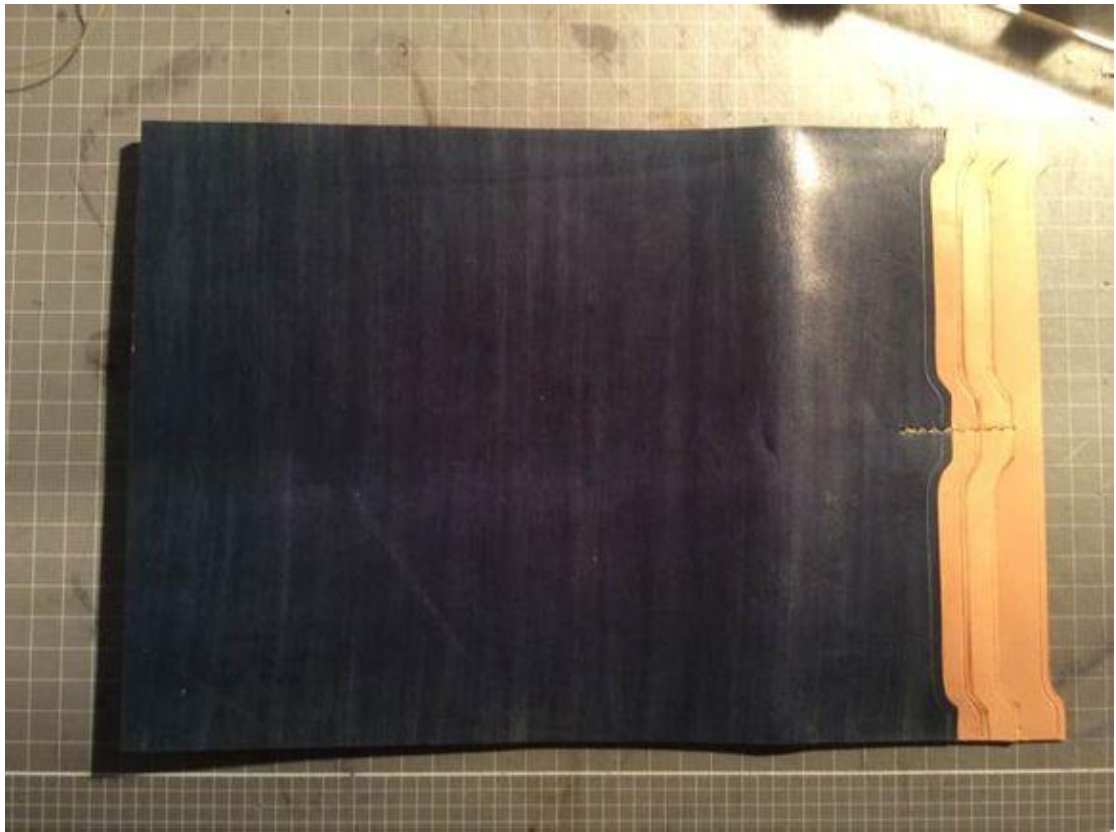
Step 13:

Prepare to combine them together. Glue them and sew the middle thread.





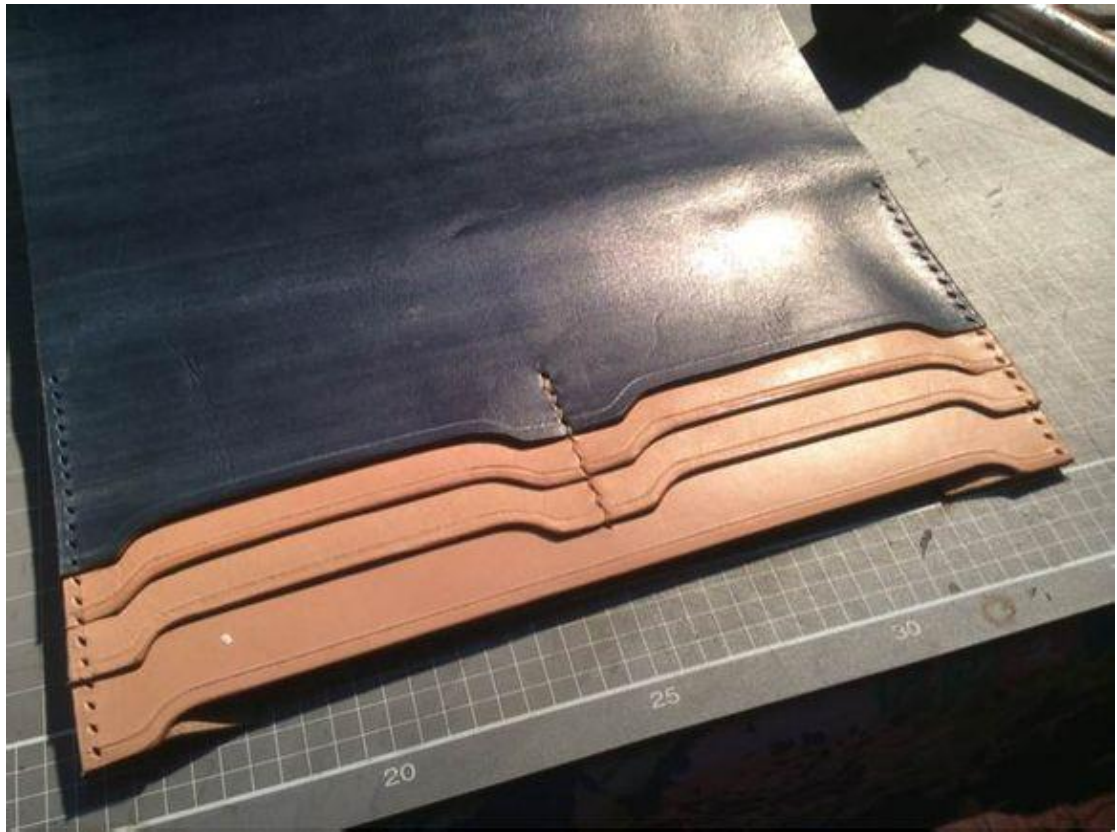






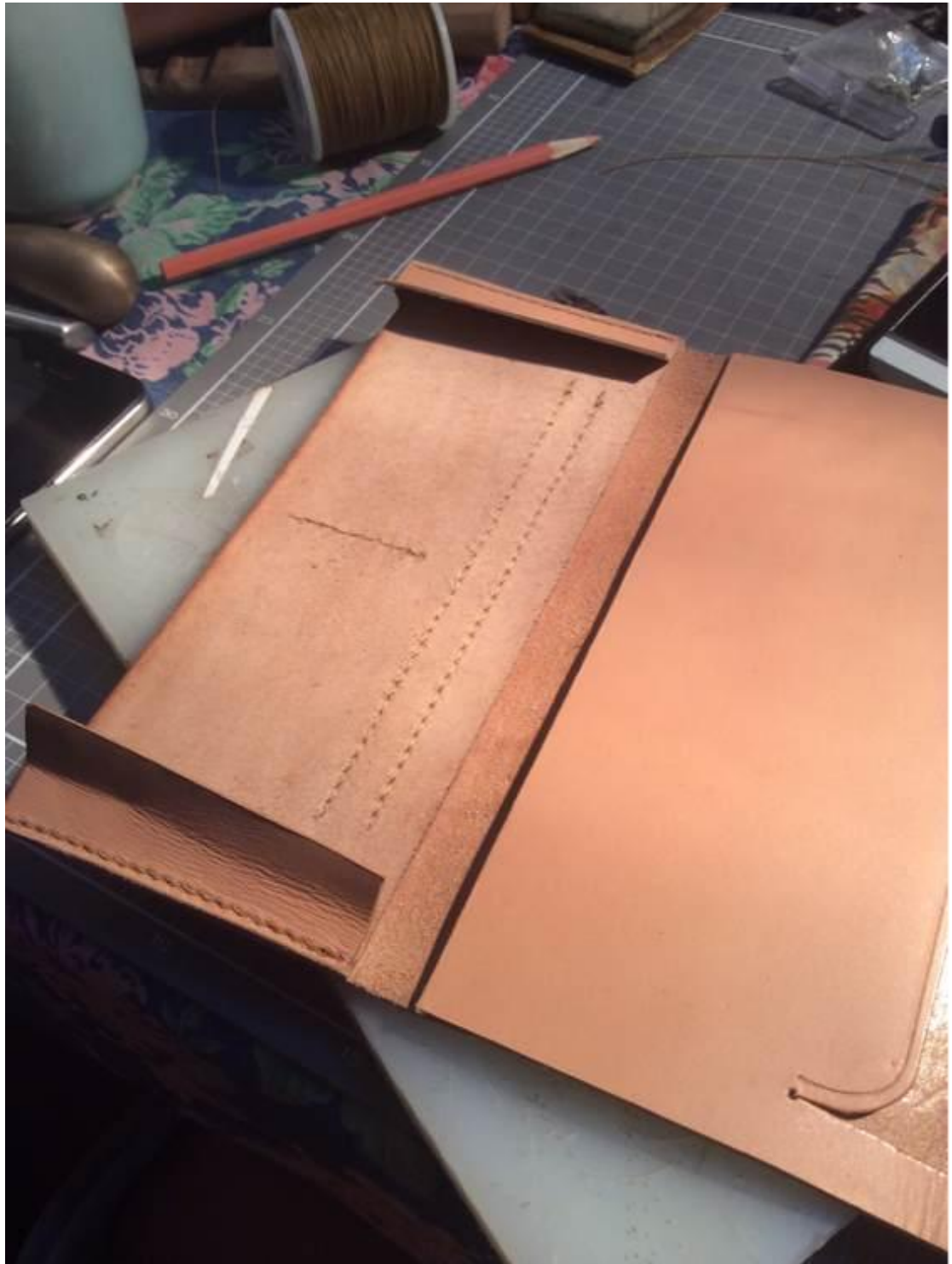
Step 14:  
Glue the two gussets on. And sew one side first.











Step 15:

Then glue the other sides together. (Actually, I suddenly found round corners are beautiful so I cut two round corners in this step)







Step 16:

OK. Let's sew the last longest thread to finish this work. Draw lines with your compass, and sew, finish.
